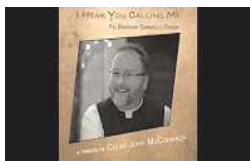
## Church Notices

When the queue of communicants has finished one minister may go down the chapel to give Communion to anyone who is unable to process to the cross aisle, and the other minister should return to the altar.
