The Commandments of God and of the Church  
*Besides believing the truths which God has revealed, what else must we do to be saved? We must keep God's commandments.*

### The Commandments of God are these 10

**First: I am the Lord thy God; thou shalt not have strange gods before me**

**Second: Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.**

**Third: Remember that thou keep holy the Sabbath day.**

**Fourth: Honour thy father and thy mother.**

**Fifth: Thou shalt not kill.**

**Sixth: Thou shalt not commit adultery.**

**Seventh: Thou shalt not steal.**

**Eighth: Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.**

**Ninth: Thou shalt not covert thy neighbour's wife.**

**Tenth: Thou shalt not covert thy neighbour's goods.**

### Data Protection Kick-Start Checklist

1. Parish Office locked when unoccupied
2. Where possible, limit public access to Parish Office
3. Ensure Parish computers and files are suitable password protected.
4. Vetting documents in a locked filing cabinet/safe/cupboard
5. Safeguarding documents in a locked filing cabinet/safe/cupboard
6. Marriage papers in a locked filing cabinet/safe/cupboard
7. Shredder in use
8. Employees have signed confidentiality agreement
9. Pastoral council have signed confidentiality agreement and consent form
10. Finance council have signed confidentiality agreement and consent form
11. Volunteers out working on behalf of the Parish have signed confidentiality agreement and consent form.
12. Signed Service Level Agreement in place with third party processors (e.g. solicitors, accounts, CCTV providers, printers)
13. Parish website has updated privacy policy
14. CCTV signage in place (where relevant)
15. Baptismal booking forms have been shredded after one year.
16. All meeting minutes reviewed
17. All letters and correspondence reviewed
18. All physical files and folders reviewed
19. All emails reviewed
20. All computers files and folders reviewed
21. Ensure Accounts files and folders are only retained for as long as necessary
22. Ensure all diaries are kept secure when not in use—not left in cars.
