The No Seven is the number of completeness in the Jewish Religion. It became so to re-inforce in peoples mind the great fact of the creation of the world in seven days by God as recorded in the Book of Genesis. The great symbol of the Jews is the seven branch candleabra which like the harp for us is very close to the Jewish heart. The term for this seven branch candleabra is the Menorah and its purpose was to highlight the seven days of creation. Because the biggest number of converts to christianity at the beginning were converts from Judaism, the early church condensed a lot of their christian ideas into settings of seven to make their 'teaching easier to accept'.
