Who can be a Confirmation Sponsor?

Confirmation Sponsors must be chosen carefully. The Church encourages candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation to invite one of their baptismal Godparents to act as their Confirmation Sponsor. This clearly expresses the link between Baptism and Confirmation. If this in not possible another Confirmation Sponsor may be chosen. A Sponsor must be chosen by the candidate, must be confirmed and practising Catholic, must be at least 16 years old and in good standing with the Church leading a life in harmony with the faith and role to be undertaken.

A Confirmation Sponsor is someone who sees that the person being confirmed acts as a true witness to Christ and is ready and willing to fulfil the continuing obligations connected with this Sacrament.
