# • <u>The Synodal Assembly in Athlone</u>

- You may be aware that there was an All-Ireland gathering in Athlone last ٠ week of the diocesan Synod groupings. The results of the findings of the meeting will be sent to Rome for the consideration of Pope Francis. One of the many ideas that emerged from the meeting was the need for an ambitious plan of adult faith formation and there was a need to work on this notion of the church to have better outreach to help people grow in faith. Also the contributions emphasised a more inclusive Church reaching out to the margins which is at the heart of the model of a missionary church. One of the heartening things that emerged was the fact that many young people spoke of having drifted away from the faith and having rediscovered their original connectedness to the Church. Time and time again in the Synodal replies people have expressed the fear that this process will go nowhere. But trust is a crucial issue here too. No one expects the level of change to come overnight but we can hope that it will come. While we await the outcome of these deliberations we can change ourselves if we want to.
