Buddhism

Alpha:

What is Alpha? Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the kerygma—the very basics of the Christian faith.

Who is it for?

Alpha is for anyone because it helps to create a space for encounter. Guests explore life, faith, and meaning in an open and welcoming environment.

How does it work?

Alpha is an 11 week course for churches to use to create a space and a culture where people are excited to bring their friends for a conversation about Jesus, Used right, Alpha can be an effective parish tool for evangelisation, discipleship and synodality. Based on hospitality, sharing, and open conversation, the same Alpha content is run all over the world, by Christians of all traditions, and provides a common expression of faith.

What does a session look like?

Hospitality - Whether in person over a meal or virtually with a cup of tea, all sessions start with a time to connect, relax, and build friendships. Eating food together creates space for people to connect and share life on a deeper level.
