Baptism - Sponsor: The most important day in a child's life is the day of the baby's baptism. The child is baptised on the strength of the father of the community and so each baby should be baptised in the church of its parents parish. The role of the sponsor is not just one of making a lovely balanced photograph but a very serious role. The sponsor has the obligation of training the child in the practice of the faith especially if the child's parents don't go to mass. For this reason the sponsor should be chosen from the local mass going population, as a sponsor who is standing for a child who lives across the sea is not in a position to give the child good example or to bring the child to pray with the local parishioners. The sponsors should be a reflection of the parents one female one male. A sponsor ought to be 16 years of age so that when the baby becomes more aware of his/her family relationships the sponsor may become an influential person for them.,

Mormon Religion otherwise known as the Church of Latter—Day Saints. In the year 1820 Joseph Smith a fifteen year old youth from upstate New York received a devine vision. He was warned by Christ through the angel "Moroni" not to join any Christian Church. Joseph Smith believed that after the resurrection Jesus visited North and South America, and established his church there as well. But Joseph Smith got into trouble when he instituted Polygamy and took as many as fifty wives himself. Polygamy - Joseph Smith preached was the ultimate solution to the evils of adultery and prostitution. America though tolerant of diverse religious beliefs would not stand for polygamy. In 1885 congress enacted laws against polygamy and its practice and between 1885 - 1890 more than 1000 Mormon men were convicted. Joseph Smith still continued to receive visions from the Mormon angel "Moroni". The members of the church of Latter - Day Saints have a great desire to spread their religion, as you may well know when they come to your home. When you open your door to them you may certainly be impressed with the amount of scripture they know. Their technique is to learn off about fifty lines of the Bible, and so they give an impression of having a deep knowledge of the scriptures. All religions have their sacred literature and for the Mormons, their sacred book of Mormon. The Book of Mormon denies the existence of "original sin" and they believe that family relationships can be forever. However they reject the "Trinity" which is key to our understanding of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. So the "Church" founded by Joseph Smith in 1830 has now split into 43 factors
