Drumkilly NS says “Yes” to Languages: The school joins 80,000 Primary pupils nationwide as they take part in Language Sampler Module: Over 53 pupils from this school are set to take part in, “Say Yes to Languages”, which started in the school on 27th Sept. 2023. The language module, which is being made available for the third year following its extension by the Department of Education has been met with overwhelming enthusiasm over the past 2 years and this interest looks set to continue with 1200 schools registered to take part in 2023/2024. Pupils of this school will be saying Oui to French, which will be delivered over an 8 week period during the normal school timetable. Mrs. Trudy Carter will be delivering the module and is excited to have the opportunity to share her passion for French with the pupils.
