The key role of the Lay pastoral worker is to co-ordinate pastoral activity. The Pastoral care would evolve visitation of the housebound/elderly/those in nursing homes and praying with them. This pastoral care supervisor would assist in organizing funerals, prayers in the home, reception of remains into the church and with bereavement ministry The programme reins for 30 months in total, one weekend per month (Friday evening and all Day Saturday for eight weekends It begins January 2025)
